## **FIM S1 and S2 SuperMoto World Championships - Changes to the 2010 Regulations -**

The Motocross/SuperMoto Grand Prix Commission, composed of Mr Wolfgang Srb, President of the CMS/FIM, Giuseppe Luongo, President of Youthstream, and Takanao Tsubouchi, MSMA Secretary General, in a meeting at the FIM Motocross Grand Prix in Agueda in Portugal, on May 10, unanimously decided to run one class only in the 2010 FIM SuperMoto World Championship. Changes are in bold characters.
